IT'S A GIRL

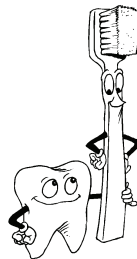
There was great excitement at Rosebud Dental Group with the arrival of Hannah Katherine Weston. Congratulations
