HCF

As well as still being choice providers for Medibank, Bupa and CBHS, Rosebud Dental recently joined with the HCF network. This means that patients with HCF private health insurance will receive better rebates on their preventative dental treatment (e.g. exam and cleans).

A reminder to all our patients that you need to bring your health insurance card to every appointment. Unfortunately the limitation with the HiCaps system is that we do need to swipe your card every time you come in for treatment as we are unable to process claims manually with a membership number.

CLOSURE OF MEDICARE TEEN DENTAL

The Medicare Teen Dental Plan will be replaced with Grow Up Smiling from 1 January 2014. Existing Medicare Teen Dental Vouchers expire on December 31st, so ensure that you book your appointment in advance.

Grow Up Smiling is a government funded program which provides a capped benefit entitlement for basic dental services for children. Around 3.4 million children aged 2-17 in families who meet a means test will be eligible for benefits each year. The means test

will be the same as the existing Medicare Teen Dental Plan, which requires receipt of Family Tax Benefit Part A or other certain government payments. Services for basic essential dental treatment, such as check-ups, x-rays, fillings and extractions will be included under Grow Up Smiling, and the total benefit entitlements will be capped at \$1000 per child over a two year period.
