## RDG COVID-19 UPDATE

### Rosebud Dental Group is Open For Emergency Dental Treatment

Your overall health is very important to us at Rosebud Dental Group and dental health plays an important part in this. We would like to take this opportunity to reassure all our patients that we always have, and always will, practice the highest infection control standards and protocols in our clinic, for our patients and our staff.

We are a voluntarily accredited Dental Practice to the National Safety Health Services Standards.

We are following all the guidelines and advice from the Victorian Department of Health and Human Services and the Australian Department of Health regarding the current CoVid19 pandemic.

In compliance with the legislation from all our governing bodies including the Australian Health Protection Principal Committee, we have progressed through Level 1, Level 2 and are now at Level 3 restrictions of practice. Under the recommended guidelines of the Australian Dental Association we can still provide treatment for your dental emergencies. However all non-urgent routine treatment must be deferred until after the current restrictions are lifted.

RDG fully supports this legislation and we are committed to all steps that help "flatten the curve". However we want to reassure you that your dental emergencies during this time can be treated in a safe sterile environment that protects both patients and our staff from cross infection. We hope this brings you some comfort at this challenging time.

All our patients who have their regular appointments cancelled during this pandemic will be recorded on our cancellation list and we will contact you as soon as our operations return to normal.
