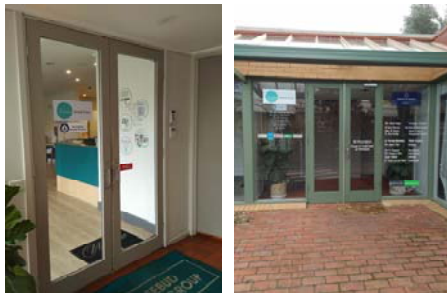

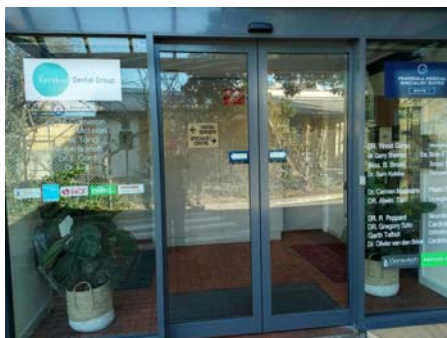
NEW DOORS
